

Featuring four multi-instrumentalists from New York City, Americana Women distinguishes themselves by their tight harmonies, sizzling solos, and passion for bringing more female artists to the spotlight. This dynamic group is sure to have you toe-tapping, clapping, and singing along to the Queens of Country and Folk! Americana Women celebrate American folk music from its earliest

origins through current country, rock, and folk. From the classic hits you grew up with to the contemporaries carrying the torch, come celebrate the women who define country and folk music. Featuring artists such as Joan Baez, Dolly Parton, Patsy Montana, Lucinda Williams, Brandi Carlile, The Chicks, as well as original music.

Allison Kelly, Bandleader, after a decade of touring with original music and theater, one thing remained constant: women’s music, songwriting, and their stories told far less than their male counterparts. Inspired to bring female artists to center stage, and to create a collective for NYC based singer/instrumentalists, Allison created Americana Women. From its earliest days, Americana Women has employed women on the creative, performing, technical, and management teams. Aside from Americana Women, favorite work includes: Monstress (Hunger and Thirst Theatre Co. NYC) Regional: The Other Josh Cohen, American Idiot, Ring of Fire, Airness, Almost Heaven: John Denver’s America. NY Workshops: Little Orphan Danny, The Hello Girls. TV: The Helpsters (Apple TV+), The 75th Annual Tony Awards (ensemble vocalist). Allison tours nationally as June Carter with Darlin’ Companion: Johnny and June Carter Cash and Not Fade Away: Rock n/ Roll Reignited. She has served as Music Director for the Roxy Regional Theatre in Clarksville, Tennessee. Her original music is available through her band, Southpaw Green, on all streaming services.

Tina Scariano is originally from Billings, Montana. Tina is now a New York City based musician, actor, and makeup artist. She has toured the country for a decade as the lead singer of A Band Called Honalee. In 2020, she debuted her solo show Feels Like Home: Celebrating the Queens of 70s Folk/Rock which has gone on to play iconic venues in NYC’s tri-state area (Birdland, 54 Below, Green Room 42) as well as tour across America. She is a member of Actors Equity, and has performed multiple contracts for Disney Cruise Line, Utah Shakespeare Festival, as well as various Off-Broadway shows. She holds a BFA in Musical Theatre from Otterbein University. When she is not performing, Tina makes magic happen behind the scenes as a makeup artist to Broadway stars & TV personalities.

Lauren Jeanne Thomas is an actress and multi-instrumentalist based in NYC. She most recently played The Fiddler in the critically acclaimed Fiddler on the Roof (in Yiddish) Off-Broadway, directed by Tony and Oscar winner Joel Grey. Select credits: Once (Reza, national tour), The Goree All-Girl String Band (NYMF), Monopoly, Songs for a New World. Concerts: Streicker Center (duet with Itzhak Perlman). BFA Acting (BU and LAMDA).

Meg Tooley played and has written with the greatest songwriters of our time (Sara Bareilles, Lori McKenna, Anais Mitchell). She earned praise as a guitarist of The Weepies, won a Latin Grammy with Spain’s Manolo Garcia, and helped orchestrate Waitress the Musical. Her songs featured on shows like “Pretty Little Liars,” “Vampire Diaries,” “Grey’s Anatomy,” and with Sara Bareilles, Gavin Creel, Cyndi Lauper, The Go Go’s, Jason Mraz, Lea Salonga, and Ruben and Clay.

CeCe Teneal’s Divas of Soul Celebrating the Women of R&B and Soul

Just a country girl from Florida born in rural Osteen (just outside of Orlando), CeCe Teneal has since brought her music to over 47 countries as the opening act for Buddy Guy, Joe Cocker, Johnny Lang, Betty Wright, Cameo, Robert Randolph & the Family Band, Jazmin Sullivan, Fantasia, Maze & Frankie Beverly, and the legendary B.B. King. In addition to DIVAS OF SOUL, CeCe currently tours her soulful and funky originals as well as a celebration of the music of Aretha Franklin to tens of thousands annually at performing arts centers around the United States and onboard multiple luxury cruise lines.

CeCe never envisioned herself as a performer, but having inherited her voice from her mother, the universe had a different plan. Nominated for four Independent Music Awards and claimed the title for 2011 Best Gospel Song (“I Heard You Prayin’”) and 2011 Best R&B Album (Train from Osteen), as well as 2018 Best Soul/Funk/Fusion Song (“Danger”). Other accolades include the 2008-2010 Orlando Best Live Band, the 2017 Orlando Music Trailblazer Award, and the honored as the halftime headliner for the 2019 Citrus Bowl. In 2022, Mayor Buddy Dyer and Mayor Jerry Demmings proclaimed September 17th as Annual CeCe Teneal Day in Orlando and Orange County respectively to celebrate her 20 years of arts and entertainment contributions. In 2023 CeCe was honored by Orlando Magic as a Diversity Game Changer for her philanthropic work in Central Florida.

A consummate performer who delivers “whether there’s 5 people or 5,000 in the audience,” (Marjorie Waldo, President & CEO of Arts Garage) CeCe seeks to transcend cultural and generational barriers with her music, and audiences can expect a new album later this year to be released on all major streaming platforms and ceceteneal.com.

Yaniv Zarif Comedy Vocalist/Polyglot

Yaniv Zarif is not just a singer—he is a one-man United Nations onstage. A global citizen and ambassador of song, Yaniv has collected more languages than most people collect socks—32 to be exact, six of which he speaks fluently, and the rest he sings with enough confidence to convince you he is a local.

This polyglot powerhouse has toured to over one hundred countries with his music and comedy, somehow avoiding jet lag through sheer vocal stamina. His musical journey began with national tours of **The Sound of Music**, followed by New York performances, alongside icons like Robin Williams, Harvey Fierstein, and Chita Rivera.

Yaniv’s critically acclaimed roles have spanned everything from **Carousel** to **Peter Pan**, **South Pacific**, and **Parade**—roles that demanded not only his powerhouse voice but also his gift for cultural understanding. Critics have praised his emotional depth, but he prefers to think of it as “singing with feeling... and sometimes an unreasonable amount of hand gestures.”

But wait, there is more! His solo show, **Polyphonic: Yaniv Zarif’s World of Song**, is not just a concert, it is an around-the-world trip, minus the hassle of airport security. With a voice that can shapeshift between French, Hebrew, Hindi, Swahili, and even American Sign Language (yes, he’s an award-winning ASL song interpreter too), Yaniv can serenade you in a dozen languages before you can even ask, “How do you say ‘amazing’ in Russian?”

He is also an accomplished yodeler, because...why not? And as a natural storyteller, Yaniv effortlessly weaves comedy, movement, and choreography into every show, creating a full-on spectacle where the only predictable thing is that you will leave laughing, clapping, and Googling “how to say bravo in 32 languages.”

Most important of all, in **Polyphonic: Yaniv Zarif’s World of Song**, each song is a passport, each language a celebration, and every moment a reminder that **music is the world’s first universal language**.
